County flags have become popular in recent years as interest in flags in England has grown. Usually flags are seen when there is a major football tournament, but more and more they can be seen flying throughout the year.

Most county flags have an historical influence usually from a particular coat of arms, whilst some others are modern. Lincolnshire's flag for example is the result of a radio competition to design a flag for the county.
